PLEASE READ CAREFULLY: DAYCARE AND BOARDING POLICIES BELOW: Daycare is on 1st page Boarding is on 2nd page! Requirements are different for daycare & boarding.

Day Care Policies help ensure the health, safety and comfort of your pet.

Age

All dogs must be at least 14 weeks of age or older, having their final Distemper/Parvo(DHLPP) vaccines along with Bordetella* and Rabies. (Required for Daycare and Boarding)

Spayed/Neuter

All dogs 1 year or older must be spayed or neutered. (Daycare only, not required for Boarding)

Vaccines

Current vaccinations are required for attending day care and must include the following: DHLPP, Rabies, and Bordetella. These vaccinations must be administered at least 7 days prior to attending day care. (Required for Daycare and Boarding)

Health

All dogs must be in good health and be treated for flea and ticks. Owners will certify their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days. Upon admission, all dogs must be free from any conditions which could potentially jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted. (Required for Daycare and Boarding)

Behavior

All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Owners will certify their dogs have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). **Please remember:** your pet will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our main concern. In the event your pet injures another dog at day care, the owner is responsible for veterinary fees and/or services. (Daycare only, not required for Boarding)

Day Care Enrollment

All dogs must have a passing assessment to be approved to attend daycare. This includes boarding dogs as well.

There is a one-time, \$25.00 non-refundable administrative assessment fee for each pet. Sometimes we are able to assess your dog while they are boarding and they will be able to attend group play, this is determined based on daycare availability and is not guaranteed.

Reservations

Reservations are required. (Required for Daycare and Boarding)

Daycare Days & Hours Tuesday – Friday: 7:30am to 6:30pm Closed on Holidays.

• There is a \$1 per minute charge for any pet left after 6pm.

Boarding Policies help ensure the health, safety and comfort of your pet.

Deposit

\$50.00 non-refundable deposit maybe required to hold and guarantee boarding reservations.

Cancellation policy/ Early departure

Cancellation without 7 days notice will have deposits forfeited. If the appropriate 7 days notice is given, your deposit can be used towards a future boarding date for up to 12 months. Cancellations within 7 days of reservation are non-refundable and not able to be used for future boarding. Payment is due for entire reserved stay if your pet is picked up earlier than expected.

Boarding Pick up & Drop off: By appointment only: Tuesday – Friday 10am-11am or 2pm-3pm. Sun & Mon 9am-

10am or 2pm-3pm. The office is closed on all holidays for drop off or pick up.

Vaccines

Current vaccinations are required for attending day care and must include the following: DHLPP, Rabies, and Bordetella. These vaccinations must be administered at least 7 days prior to attending day care. ~ Vaccine proof can be emailed to info@k9barksnbrews.com by your vet or you can take a picture of the proof and attach it to the email.

Bedding & Toys

Clean, fresh linens provided everyday. We also provide comfortable beds, blankets and toys to make your pet feel right at home.

We enforce and have strict policies for sanitary reasons we only accept one small blanket and one toy, we do not accept bedding, bowls, or crates of any sort and will return upon check -in.

Bowls

Food/water bowls are provided. We also have raised feeders and slow feeder bowls upon request.

Food & Medication

Please put all food in labeled baggies or containers not exceeding 5lbs per container. We do not accept large food bags or storage bins.

All medications must be in original bottle with correct instructions on the label. Medication fees apply per day.

Age Requirement

Dogs over 10 years old will require a vet release for boarding.

* These vaccines are generally not part of routine vaccine protocol and may need to be requested from your veterinarian.
